- •Vs. 20-21: Noah creates the problem
- •Vs. 22: Ham exacerbates the problem
- •Vs. 23: Shem and Japheth solve the problem
- •Vs. 24-27: Canaan is cursed as a result of the problem

3 Enter the bad hermeneutic...

- •Ham's name and the Hamitic curse(?)
- •The Koran and resultant Arabic worldviews (9th/10th Century)
- •The Talmud translation in 15th Century
- •The church in the 15th Century
- •Forget what the rest of the Bible says...right?

4 Perpetuation of the Hamitic Curse Myth

Replacement Theology: Japheth replaces Shem (the church replaces Israel)

Apartheid: Racial prejudice institutionalized

5 Jesus Christ...the Lasting Solution

- •Colossians 2:8-15
- We are dead, alive and filled in Christ.
- •Ephesians 2:13-16
- We are brought near, reconciled and have peace with God in Christ.
- •Galatians 3:26-28
- •We are different but one body in Christ.

Therefore, do not fall prey to empty lies and deceptions, vain philosophies and human traditions!
