The second attitude (chapter 2) of a church member in the book entitled, "I am a Church Member" by Thom S Rainier discusses **Unity in the Body of Christ.** John 13:35 says, "By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another." We want to say, "Hey God, that's not easy. You want me to love that person that sits on the other side of church who I just cannot imagine ever being associated with?"

The answer is "Yes". Period. Easy or not.

Let me refer to Eph 1:15-16, where Paul says to the church of Ephesus, "This is why since I heard about your faith in the Lord Jesus and your love for all the saints, I never stop giving thanks for you as I remember you in my prayers." Paul also urged the church members later, "to walk worthy of the calling you have received, with all humility and gentleness, with patience, accepting one another in love, diligently keeping the unity of the Spirit with the peace that binds us." (Eph 4:1-3) Wow, that sounds like we need the Holy Spirit (Gal 5:22-23) to lead our lives and enable us to be a unified church.

Each of us has the responsibility to be a source of unity, and to love all our fellow church members unconditionally. It doesn't mean you have to agree with everyone all the time, but it does mean that at times you are willing to sacrifice your own preferences to keep unity in our church. That's a tall order.

So, what can we do to prevent disunity in our church? In Romans 1:29-31 we find a list of unrighteous acts: greed, wickedness, envy, murder, strife, deceit, malice, gossip, slander, arrogance, pride, boastfulness, evil, and much more! We all have been guilty of something on that list at some time in our lives.

In the middle of that list of sins is GOSSIP; 'casual or unconstrained conversation or reports about other people, typically involving details that are not confirmed as being true'. Gossip can easily destroy the unity of a church. As we see in James 3:6 "And the tongue is a fire, a world of unrighteousness. The tongue is set among our members, staining the whole body, setting on fire the entire course of life, and set on fire by hell."

How do we prevent the spread of gossip? We start by **not being the source** of gossip.

You must ask yourself if what you are sharing is actually factual. Then, we make sure we are **not allowing it to spread.** We need to be courageous enough to rebuke/admonish a person when they are spreading gossip to you. How do I do that? Kindly say you would rather not hear any gossip and you would hope it doesn't continue to spread. If we can be brave enough to do this, it will promote unity in the body, and beyond! Speculation about something can also be the root of rumors and gossip. I encourage you to be in *good communication* with others and **seek out the truth** of a matter before speaking about it to others. Even ask yourself, "Is this something I need to share, or can I just ignore it and let it go?"

The third piece of unity is **forgiveness**. Matt 6:14-15 states, "For if you forgive people their wrong doing, your heavenly Father will forgive you as well. But if you don't forgive people your Father will not forgive your wrong doing." Doesn't that sound like it is in our best interest to **forgive others?** We may find ourselves being unforgiving to fellow church members, Pastors, Elders, and even our own family, because of things that were said and done. (Like gossip!) Paul said in Col 3:12-13, "Therefore, God's chosen ones, holy and loved, put on heartfelt **compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience,** accepting one another and forgiving one another if anyone has a complaint against another. Just as the Lord has forgiven you, so you must also forgive." There are those spiritual attributes again! (Highlighted for you).

If case you haven't noticed, we are all as imperfect as each other. None of us is without fault here. We will make mistakes. We will sin. We can all be hypocritical.

Church unity can be destroyed when we refuse to forgive... but thanks be to God for His grace!

Therefore, let's use the attributes we received from the Holy Spirit when we accepted Jesus into our lives to **forgive others, rebuke gossip, show love** to all our members and become a unified church. We will receive the loving approval of the Creator who made us for His purpose.
