
BLESSINGS FROM ABOVE

Monthly Reflection

Blessings From Above

I have read and been told that blessings come in different forms. There are the ones we gladly hold out our hands to accept and enjoy, "Sure I'll take that one", and then there are the ones that are grievous and painful that we struggle to accept.



We make a fist and do not extend our open hand, "Please, not that one Lord."

What can be even more difficult is that these blessings do not always seem to be given out equally. We may find ourselves continually in that later blessing category while we watch others eagerly accepting blessings of the first form with an open hand. We can become bitter and hold it against the one who is blessed so favorably and question God's love for us. We can compare and compete turning it into a battle of considerable proportion, stealing our sense of contentment and joy. We may not even realize it is happening because the Deceiver is subtle and sneaky. We may not recognize it until it has a strong foothold in our mind and heart.

Firstly, if you find yourself in a place of struggle, realize that we all face trials of varying degrees. That is what much of this life consists of, but it is not God's ultimate plan for His creation. We were designed by a Creator who has a plan to restore our brokenness - all of it, in every way, and for eternity. As a Christ follower we will hopefully come to trust that our Father knows us so well and loves us so deeply that we can accept either type of blessing eagerly. It is in opening our fist to those grievous blessings that we learn just who we are in Christ and know His deep love for us.

Secondly, if you find yourself in a place of comfort and ease, you have a great responsibility. When you encounter anyone who has been required to accept a blessing that causes grief, be sensitive to their needs. Unfortunately, we can unknowingly contribute to someone's struggle with bitterness and jealousy when we continually report how lovely our life is. Understand that not everyone is on a road they would choose for themselves, and it can be painful to hear about those who are. A listening ear and a sensitive spirit are invaluable to a hurting, broken heart.

I am always in awe when I remember how God has brought me through some painful experiences where I was required to open my fist to accept a blessing I did not want. But when I did, He met me with unconditional love even at my lowest points. He then ultimately provided healing and restored my faith through the blessing of trials. It is in those times that I better understood the value of accepting all <u>Blessings from Above</u>.
